Diet Type Report	To see a list of certain diets or modified liquids. Order Listing Report	In busy buildings with multiple new orders daily to see who has therapy orders(this method only works if you discharge eval. orders regularly-otherwise you will see all orders, not just new ones)	Daily in busy facilities.
